MEMBERS:

FULL TIME - 5 DAYS A WEEK

School year (September - December)

- Charged Monthly \$243.35 per month

PART TIME

School year (January – June and September - December)

- 3 days \$167.90 per month
- 2 days \$111.95 per month
- Half time \$140.00 per month
- Extra day \$13.00

Part-time space is only available with a partnering family. A 15% administrative fee is charged on member fees to determine the part time fee. Part time is based on space availability and is not guaranteed as a long-term option. Part-time enrollment is the responsibility of the two (2) partnering families involved to make sure that the space shared is a full-time space. Should a partnering family leave the Centre, the remaining family is responsible for the full-time rate until a replacement partnering family is found.

- School Day (Before and after school) \$13.00
- PA Day (including Christmas and March break) \$29.00

SCHOOL-AGE RATES INCLUDE:

- Age appropriate/child centered programming and activities
- All programming trips and activities
- AM and afternoon PM snack
- Statutory Holidays (as per parent handbook)

TERMS

1. Fees are due on the first day of each month.
2. Post-dated cheque for the first month may be requested at the time of enrollment. If PAD is the chosen form of payment, this cheque will not be deposited and will be returned or destroyed.
3. Monthly fees include all statutory holidays.
4. A late fee of \$5 per day may be charged on past due accounts.
5. A fee of \$48 will be charged for each Not-Sufficient Funds (NSF) cheque or insufficient PAD payment.
6. Notice of withdrawal must be given to the Sunnyside Garden Daycare Centre in writing at least four weeks prior to withdrawal.
7. If a child is absent without notice for longer than four weeks, the child will be considered withdrawn from the Sunnyside Garden Daycare Centre.
8. Toronto Children's Services guidelines and Sunnyside Garden Daycare Centre policies will apply for families receiving subsidies from the City of Toronto.
9. Fees are established annually (generally in the fall of the year) by the Sunnyside Garden Daycare board of Directors and any changes are communicated in writing to parents/guardians with a minimum two months' notice.
